8. COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVE COMMENTS

Mr A Brown asked why the drilling rigs were being used in the area. Mr Sutherland advised that the rigs were for confirming geological information and quality information.

Mr Blackham advised that there was a band in the floor that was extremely hard and in general the coal seam was 2.1 m above the band. Mr Blackham said that this was one of the reasons that the drilling was being undertaken.

Mr McPherson also advised that on the eastern side of the area, a statistical model of the resource had been used with 200 m centres. They are duplicating this on the western side.

Mr B Ure asked when the Subsidence Management Plan for area 2 would be prepared. Mr Sutherland advised that it would be done by the end of September/October, 2010.

Mr Ure asked when do you do the Landholder Agreements done? Mr McPherson advised that they would be done during the SMP 2 process.

Mr Sutherland advised than the SMP Area 2 touches eleven different properties. They will commence the SMP process with a stakeholder meeting on the 9th September, 2010.
